FOH:

Professional 16-channel console, preferably digital (we double up the tracks to have different EQs and to manage monitor mixes from FOH) Ideally: Yamaha CLI, Midas M32 R

PLEASE NOTE: Wherever possible, the FOH engineer should be situated on the centre line of the stage, 2/3 of the distance between front of stage and back of venue. Please do not place FOH engineers in booths, beneath balconies, or against walls.

FOH Sound system:

Professional system with enough power for the venue in question, capable of producing uniform sound pressure levels everywhere in the room without distortion. (L-Acoustics, D&B, Amadeus, Adamson ...)

In certain situations (small-capacity venues, <80 people), the group may perform with a small sound system for the saxophones only, or even without a sound system.

Monitor system:

 4×12 " coaxial wedge monitors on 4 different circuits, equalised. (MTD 112, MAX 12, PMX 12)

PLEASE NOTE: if the concert is outside on an open stage, please provide 2 additional 15" coaxial monitors on stands.

Timetable:


Once the musicians have set up and the microphones are connected (approx. 30 minutes), please allow **Ih for the soundcheck**.
